Aji Amarillo

This fruity flavored and aromatic Peruvian pepper is incorporated into many dishes, adding mild spice and a pleasant yellow color. This pepper can also be mixed with oil and used as a flavorful condiments or dipping sauce.

Yucca (yoo-ka)

This Peruvian root is a dietary staple usually eaten boiled, steamed, or fried and can be an excellent substitute for potatoes on any dish. Here at Mango, we like it best fried and served with a side of *Aji Amarillo* dipping sauce!

Queso Fresco

Latin American fresh cheese is used to compliment salads and is a main ingredient in our popular *Huancaína* dressing.

Salsa Criolla

Marinated onion with plenty of tangy and spicy flavors, a sort of pickled onion salsa!

Cancha & Chifles

Cancha are salty, fried corn kernels, typically served as snack food in lieu of peanuts or pretzels, or on the side of ceviche; while *Chifles* are salty chips made of plantain, a member of the banana family.
